

AIMS OF EU ONLINE PROJECT

The aim of the project “**Developing EU through online innovation**” is to analyze the labor market needs in each partner country in order to identify the emerging professions and adult learners' needs, to create a transnational report on the training needs, to create 7 digital online training courses following the analysis of the training needs, to improve the content and delivery of adult education, to provide adult educators with a set of creative and critical thinking strategies to use in adult learning contexts by creating a manual on how to develop the following themes in adult education:

- Creativity and innovation in adult education
- Lateral thinking in action on organizing self-development courses in adult education
- Management of adult education organizations
- Sustainability in adult education
- The necessity of Lifelong learning in adult education
- Application of interactive methods in adult training

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WHAT IS EU ONLINE PROJECT?

Nowadays, nearly all job positions require digital skills, especially in jobs where digital technology complements the existing tasks. In the near future, 90% of jobs - in careers such as engineering, accountancy, nursing, medicine, art, architecture, and many more - will require some level of digital skills. Consequently, online education has now become essential in nearly every job position, and the aim of EU Online project is to address this gap in the acquisition of digital skills by adults, and their further training on the topic.

WHO IS IT FOR?

One of the most important objectives of distance learning is to make sure that **learners who cannot attend formal education institution** or adult education centres due to some obstacles

such as a disability, time of place restrictions or work conditions also receive training. The idea of the EU Online project is to **remove the barriers** of physical space and time by offering online courses available to the public.

TRANSNATIONAL MEETINGS

Four transnational meetings have taken place so far:

1. Kick-off meeting in Latvia (October, 2015)
2. Spain (April, 2016)
3. Cyprus (June, 2016)
4. Hungary (October, 2016)

During the transnational meetings in each country, several issues were discussed regarding the project's development, such as the development of the transnational report on the training needs of each country, the development of the online training courses, and decisions were taken regarding the progress of the project.
